

# Inland Seas Camps Young Women in STEM

August 21 - 23

This three-day, overnight research-based program for young women (incoming or current high school) will allow you to eat, sleep, and work aboard the schooner Inland Seas while exploring the functioning and health of the Great Lakes. During the voyage, you will study and analyze fish, plankton, water and lake sediment and develop a research project on invasive species or other topics of interest. You'll also help the crew with vessel operation including hoisting and handling sails, plotting and steering a course, and assisting with meals in the galley.
